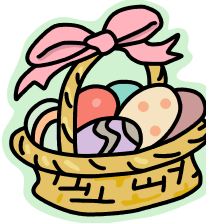

When we were kids we always looked forward to Easter because we usually got a new pair of shoes or a new dress to wear to church on Easter Sunday. Of course we always hoped the weather was good so that we actually got to wear the new duds on that day. I remember when I was about 13 or 14, I got a new pair of shoes that had Queen Ann heels. I tried those shoes on so many times I probably had them worn out by the time Sunday got there. How I loved those shoes. Here is something else I love, French Toast for brunch on Easter Sunday.

Grand Marnier French Toast Bake

- 8 Thick slices of day old French bread (about ¾ inch thick)
- 4 Large eggs
- ¾ Cup Half & Half cream
- 2 Tbsp sugar
- 1 Tbsp finely grated orange zest
- ½ Tsp vanilla extract
- ¼ Cup Grand Marnier orange flavoured liqueur *
- Pinch of Salt
- Butter to grease 9x13 inch baking dish

Arrange the bread slices in the bottom of the dish in a single layer. Whisk together the eggs, half and half, Grand Marnier, sugar, grated orange zest, vanilla extract and the salt. Pour this mixture over the bread slices, pressing on the bread to help absorb the liquid. Cover and refrigerate one hour or overnight. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. Remove the cover from the baking dish and let stand for 20 minutes at room temperature. Bake for 35 minutes until golden brown. Dust with confectioner's sugar before serving.

* Thawed frozen orange juice concentrate can be substituted for the liqueur.

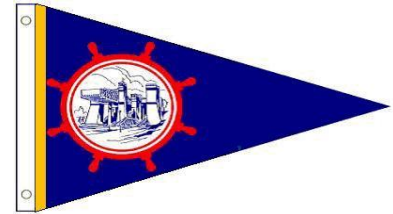
