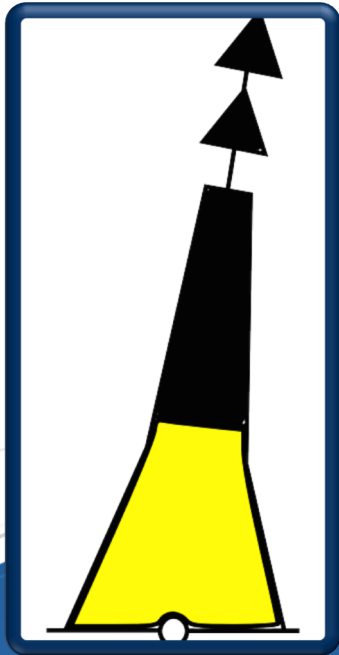
As an organization of volunteers, we promote safe boating and effective navigation in the Peterborough and Kawartha Lakes region through training and service to boaters of all ages and abilities

# Chart your course for boating education



Fall Courses:

**Boating 2: Beyond the PCOC - Basics:** Build your arsenal of boating safety strategies through presentations and discussion of topics such as aids to navigation, anchoring, use of different types of line, what to do in case of emergency and weather. Courses are interactive, and fun for all ages.

**Boating 3: Introduction to Navigation:** Learn basic navigation skills such as conning, navigating underway, learning to use a compass and reading and charting a simple course on paper charts – a good preparation for understanding principles of electronic navigation.

Fall and Spring: – **VHF Marine Radio** certification course
